

## **RULES AND CRITERIA FOR SELECTION PROCESS**

- A. The SCSSC has established a Hall of Fame to recognize those outstanding athletes, teams and supporters that have made the organization great.
- B. Forms for the Hall of Fame nominations will be available by request or online at [www.scseniorgames.com](http://www.scseniorgames.com) by December 1<sup>st</sup>.
- C. Nominations shall be submitted to the SCSSC Hall of Fame Committee before January 12, 2018

- D. The selection committee shall consist of a Chairperson to serve a four (4) year term; Board members, sponsors, etc. to be determined by the chairperson.
- E. Inductions shall be awarded at the CELEBRATION OF ATHLETES of the South Carolina Senior Sports Classic (SCSSC) State Senior Games. A reception will follow the ceremony.
- F. Nominations will be held for a period of four (4) years.
- G. Selectees shall be inducted every two (2) years.
- H. The candidates shall have participated in the SCSSC State Senior Games for a minimum of ten years.
- I. The candidates must be a resident of South Carolina.
- J. A special category for coaches, sponsors, leaders, organizations, etc. who have contributed to the vision of the SCSSC and its mission.
- K. Recipients shall be given a choice of the following awards: A ring, a broach or a plaque. Special category recipients and those accepting for posthumous recipients will receive a plaque.
- L. Criteria to be considered during the selection.
  - 1. Multiple medal winners on the state and/or national level.
  - 2. State record holders
  - 3. Year round performance achievers
  - 4. Outstanding contributors on the local, state or national level toward the cause of senior health.
  - 5. Continuous support of the SCSSC and its goals.
